






Begin at the Atlas of Living Australia homepage and select "Species by location".



Select "Explore your area".



## ALA Teacher Guide: Finding the species recorded in your area


You will see a map with a place mark in the middle of a circle that contains coloured dots showing the occurrence records.

The list shows all the species found at that location, as well as the number of records.



You can filter the list so it only shows the records you are looking for.

You can view a list of all the records in the selection or download the records, download a species checklist, or download a field guide for those species.



By clicking on the individual occurrences on the map, you will get details for that particular record and you can open them up and view them.
