

ALA User Guide 1: Finding the species recorded in your area

Begin at the Atlas of Living Australia homepage and click on the Explore by location tile.



Explore by location Browse species by pre-defined region or by location.



Select "Explore your area".

Explore your area

Simply enter an address or location to find the recorded species nearby. You can set the size of the search area and download the results.

Once you enter your postcode or address, a map will appear with coloured dots showing the occurrence records. You can alter the radius of the circle.
