



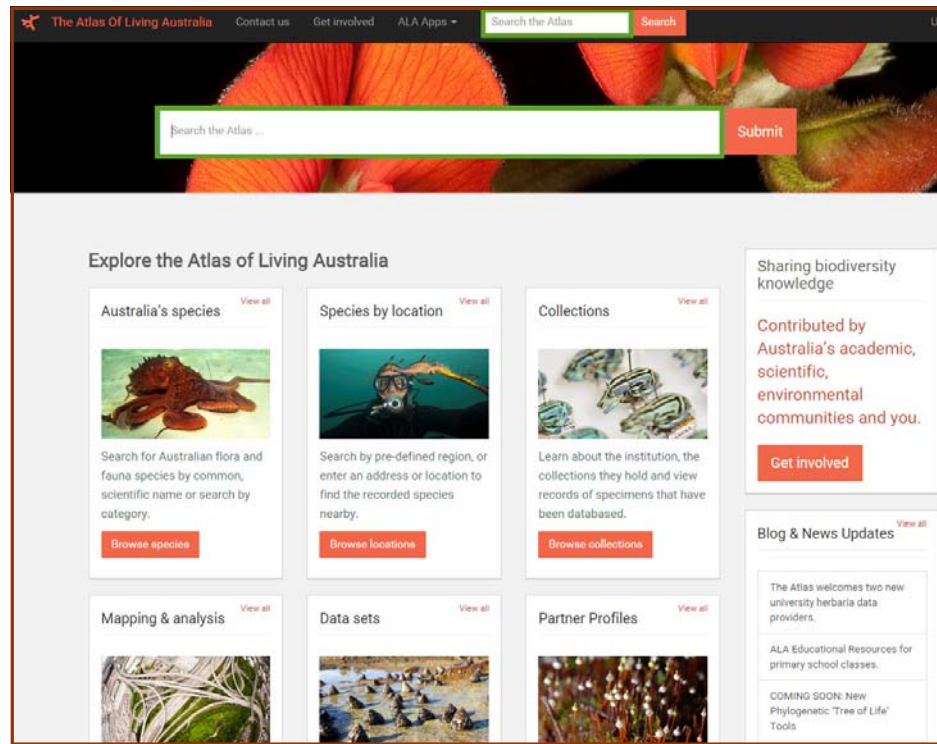
# Does a species occur in my area?

Begin at the Atlas of Living Australia homepage. Type the species or common name in either of the search boxes at the top

**Compiled distribution map**



You will then see the “Occurrence records map” for that particular species. In some cases, you will also see a “Compiled distribution map” for that species. The “Occurrence records map” shows all the sightings for that species. There is a scale next to the map showing occurrence frequency.
